



INTRODUCTORY COURSE IN COUPLE COUNSELLING AND PSYCHOTHERAPY



Overview:

The course is specifically designed to provide participants with the opportunity of learning more about couple work, the special character of the marital/couple focus and the theory underpinning this approach. In addition, the training can improve personal and professional relationships through developing greater selfawareness and an enhanced understanding of the dynamics inherent in any family or social group.



Specifically the course covers:

- Introduction to psychodynamic way of working with clients
- Introduction to the particular skills of a couples therapist
 - Exploration of the dynamics of the couple relationship

- Theory seminars

- Clinical seminars

- Qualification: MA Couple and Individual Psychodynamic Counselling and Psychotherapy



Psychoanalytic Pathway

- Individual supervision
- Longer term clinical work
- 2 co-therapy cases
- Psychiatric placement
- Infant observation
- 3 x week personal psychoanalytic psychotherapy
- Qualification: MA Couple Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy



Professional Doctorate

- After a clinical couple qualification
- ▶ Taught part in years 1 & 2
- ▶ Research part in years 2 4
- Tutorials and research supervision
- 40,000-60,000 word dissertation in a couple-related area
